Licence is hereby granted, under and subject to the provisions of the Bombay Prohibition Act 1949 (Bom XXV of 1949), and the rules, regulations and orders madethere under to **Jagdamba Education Society's Matoshri Asarabai Darade Haomeopathic Hospital, At.Po.Bhabhulgaon, Tal-Yeola, Dist- Nashik** (herein-after called "the licensee") on payment of a fee of **Rs.1010 /-**, in advance, authorising him to buy, possess and use rectified spirit including absolute alcohol (herein called "spirit") during the period from **07/2017** to **31/03/2018** his premisses situated at **At.Po.Bhabhilgaon, Tal-Yeola, Dist- Nashik** (hereinafter referred to as "the licensed premises") subject to the following conditions. namely:-

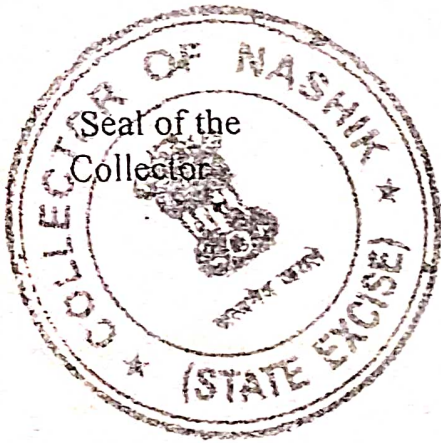

1. The licensee shall not use the spirit for any purpose except for
2. (1) The licensee shall not buy spirit except on a requisition countersigned by an officer of the Prohibition and Excise Department duly authorized in that behalf :  
[Provided that no such requisition shall be necessary for a licensee who has obtained an order of exemption under rule 16-B of the Bombay Rectified Spirits Rule 1951]
- (2) The licensee shall not buy spirit in any one month/during the period of the licence more than [**240 bulk liter Rectified Spirits and 120 bulk liter Absolute Alcohol / bottles of 750 / Per Year mililitres each]** in the aggregate.
- (3) The licensee shall not use spirit exceeding bulk [ -- bulk liter Rectified Spirits and --- bulk liter Absolute Alcohol- bottles of 750 ] in any one month.

times be open to inspection by the Collector, or any Prohibition and Excise or Police Officer no lower in rank than a Sub-Inspector of Prohibition and Excise or Police, as the case may be, or by any other officer empowered under section 77(a) of the Bombay Prohibition Act 1949, who may be deputed or authorized by the Collector or the Superintendent of Prohibition and Excise [or the District Inspector Prohibition and Excise] in this behalf.

8. The accounts, requisitions and transport passes referred to in condition 5 and the licence shall be preserved by the licensee during the whole of the period of this licence.
